

Classification Days

Classification days are open to current members of Merlin Field Archers and other Guest members who hold a valid 2020 EFAA membership card. Current membership cards must be presented on the day to prove membership, but will not be collected.

Archers

- Remember your alcohol gel and a mask (there are points on the course where archers cannot maintain 2m distance, so will need to wear a mask whilst still maintaining 1m+)

Facilities

There will be no food or tea and coffee provided, archers will be asked to bring their own. There will be no seating facilities.

There will be one toilet open at the target 14/15 rest area and one available at the main club hut, along with the gents urinal. There will be alcohol hand gel and disinfectant wipes available that should be used to wipe down the contact surfaces after each use. Please use the bin provided to dispose of wipes.

Booking

All archers must pre-book these sessions by the Friday of the shoot week. This will allow time to issue start times to each shooting group. Guests will be asked to pay a £10 shooting fee in advance, members will have no charge (for the remainder of 2020). Bank details will be available on request. Start times will be between 8:30 and 10:30. You will be allowed to turn up 40 minutes before your start time. This includes set up, practice and check in. Please do not try to arrive any earlier than necessary. Practice butts are available up to 40 Yards. Please respect other archers by maintaining social distancing in the car park, practice butts and the club house area.

Score Cards

2 scorers will be allocated per group. Scorers will only touch their own cards. Cards should be visually checked by the archer, but only signed by the individual scorer. Please see classification regulations for information about claiming awards.

Test and Trace

For the purposes of the Government's test and Trace system, we will be required to collect a small amount of personal data. This will comprise of the name, address and telephone number from one member of your household. This information will be stored securely and we will delete this information 21 days after the Shoot date.

General Guidance

Please do not travel to an event if:

- You are from a 'lockdown' area
- You have had COVID 19 symptoms such as high temperature, a new continuous cough or a loss / change to smell or taste within the last 10 days
- A member of your household has demonstrated COVID symptoms within the last 14 days

Do not overtake on the course, leave a clear gaps between groups
